Voting in Pennsylvania: What YOU Need to Know

How changes in the law affect you for the April 24, 2012 Primary

You are **NOT** required to show photo identification when you vote on April 24<sup>th</sup>\*.

The new Pennsylvania government-issued photo voter ID law **WILL NOT BE** in effect for the April 24<sup>th</sup> primary. You may be asked to present photo ID but **only** voters who are voting for the first time or who have not previously voted in their election district will be required to show ID. All other voters can still vote a regular ballot if they do not present ID. If you are turned away at the polls on April 24<sup>th</sup> for not showing ID, call **1-866-OUR-VOTE (1-866-687-8683)**.

\*The photo ID requirement **will be** in effect for the General Election on November 6, 2012. If you need to know what type of ID is accepted or need help obtaining ID please call **1-866-OUR-VOTE**.
