This week is **Black Census Week**, and with the COVID-19 pandemic affecting our day-to-day lives, it is even more critical that there be a full and complete Census count.

April 1, 2020 is Census Day. Participating in the census is vital as it determines resources for your community that include:

- federal funding,
- congressional representation
- funding for new schools, hospitals, roads and more.

The Census can be completed online, through the mail, or by phone, making it convenient for every citizen to participate.

NAACP National President and CEO Derrick Johnson is emphasizing the work that needs to be done in making sure everyone gets counted. Therefore, branches I am asking that you through emails, phone calls, teleconferencing, etc., please make sure that you promote individuals to complete their census form by April 1st. If you are able, get folks to report that they have completed their forms.
